





Publishing specimen images online?

 If we all use the same interface to our images then it is possible to build tools that work the same across all our collections




- IIIF is pronounced Triple-Eye-Eff
- IIIF is widely used in the Digital Humanities and becoming widespread in the Natural History community too
- IIIF is a series of open APIs that specify how images are published
- IIIF is a collection of open tools that allow users to work with images across multiple institutions
- IIIF is a community of developers, implementers and institutions who develop
