Use the **International Image Interoperability Framework !**

- If we all use the same interface to our images then it is possible to build tools that work the same across all our collections
- IIF is pronounced Triple-Eye-Eff
- IIF is widely used in the Digital Humanities and becoming widespread in the Natural History community too
- IIF is a series of open APIs that specify how images are published
- IIF is a collection of open tools that allow users to work with images across multiple institutions
- IIF is a community of developers, implementers and institutions who develop and support the technology
