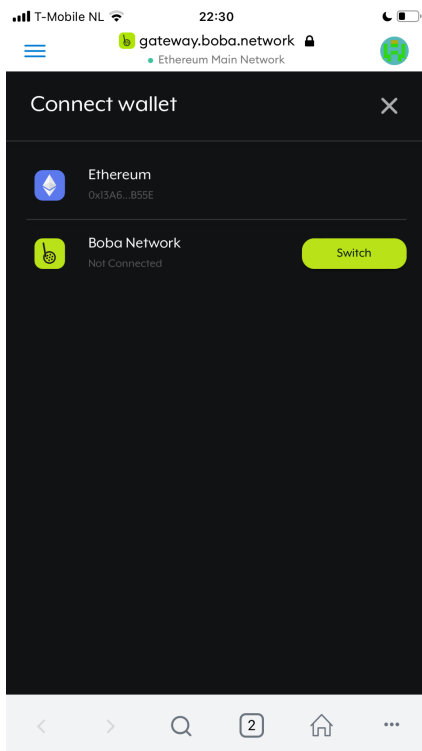


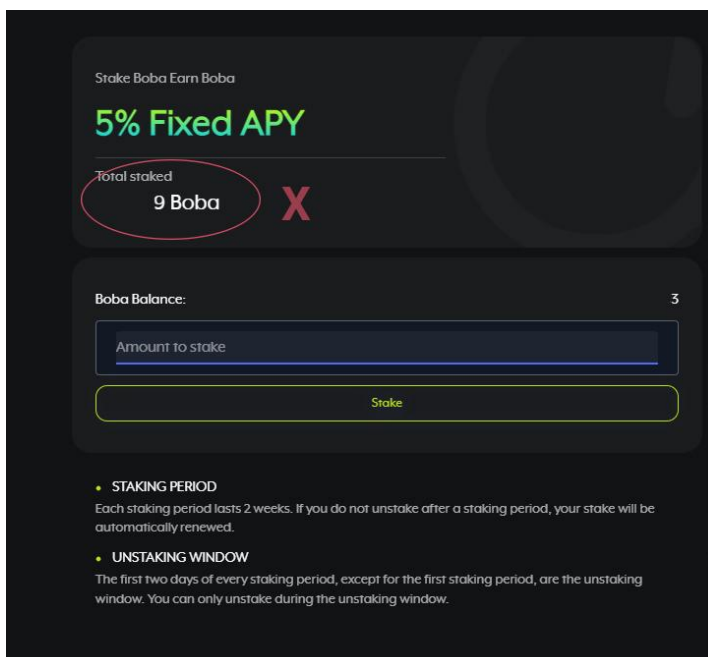
Feedback (Gateway)

Issue (priority)

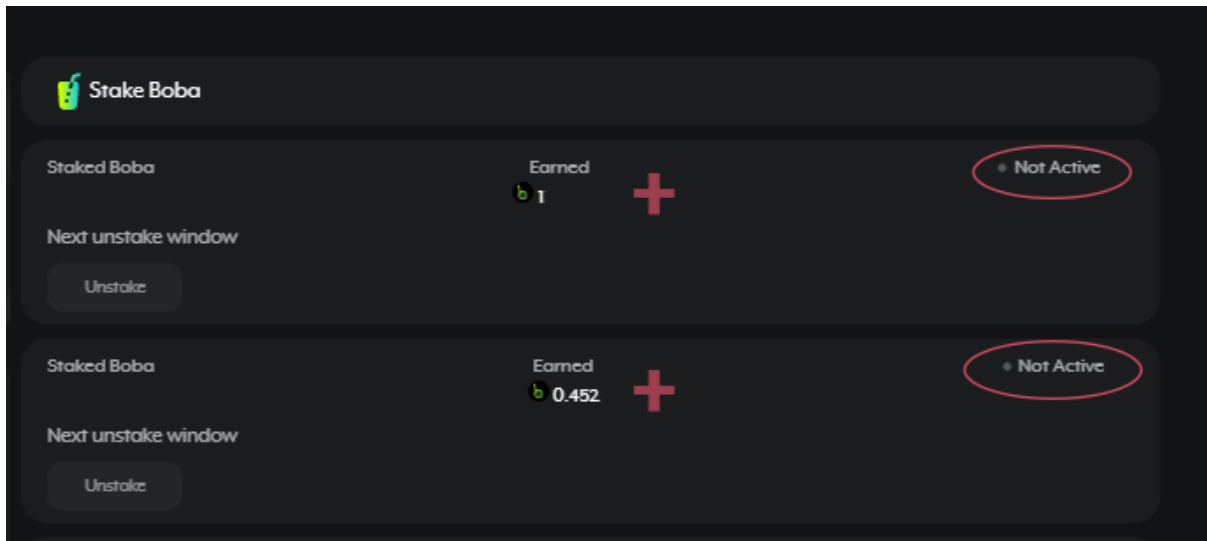
1. Copy wallet address button **not** showing in the gateway on mobile (IOS Iphone). I have no idea how to copy my address and share it.



2. Fixed 5% staking - Total amount staked is **wrong**. It is also factoring in the not active stake you have. So if you start with **3** (xBoba) and you unstake and re-stake 2 times. You will end up with a **9** total amount staked display. But you only got **3 staked** (xBoba).

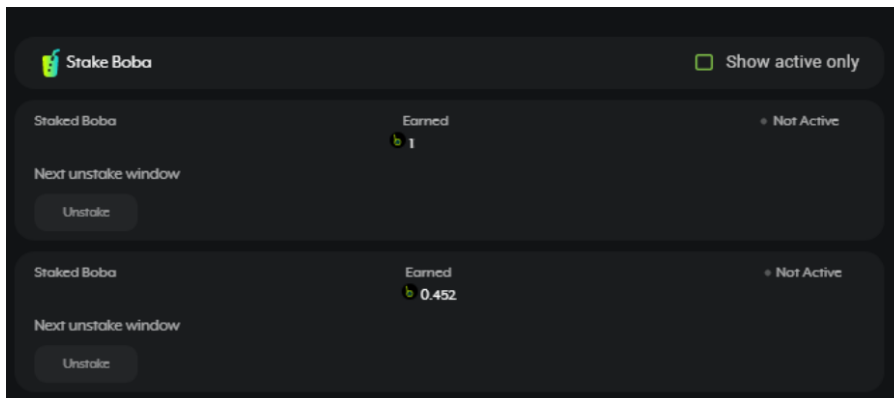


3. Fixed 5% staking - Rewards display continues to add up rewards on not active stake

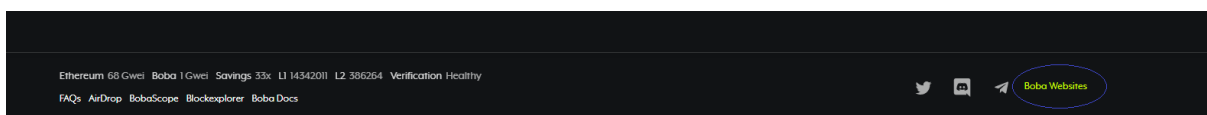


4. Fixed 5% staking - The “unstake button” will be highlighted for the next 2 days when your stake is “not active” anymore. After 2 weeks, this process repeats itself. In other words, the button should be ‘grayed out’ for ever, the second you unstaked your xBoba’s

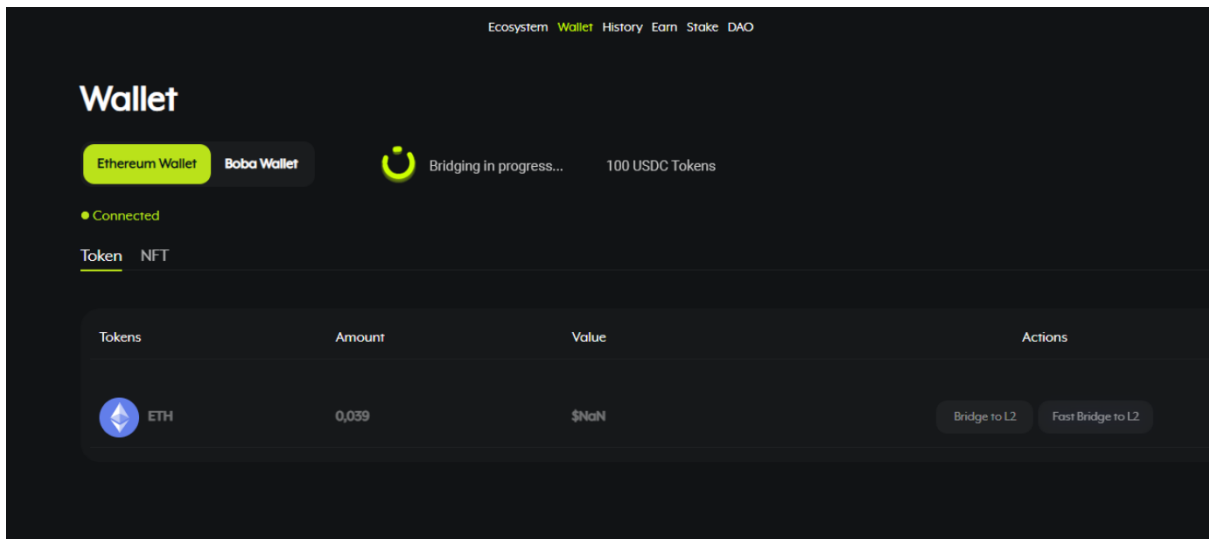
5. Fixed 5% staking - Make a button to hide the ‘not active’ stake. In some sort of history window or a simple check box like on the earn page “show active/staked only”. Because my gateway is getting spammed with a long list of “not active” stake amounts.



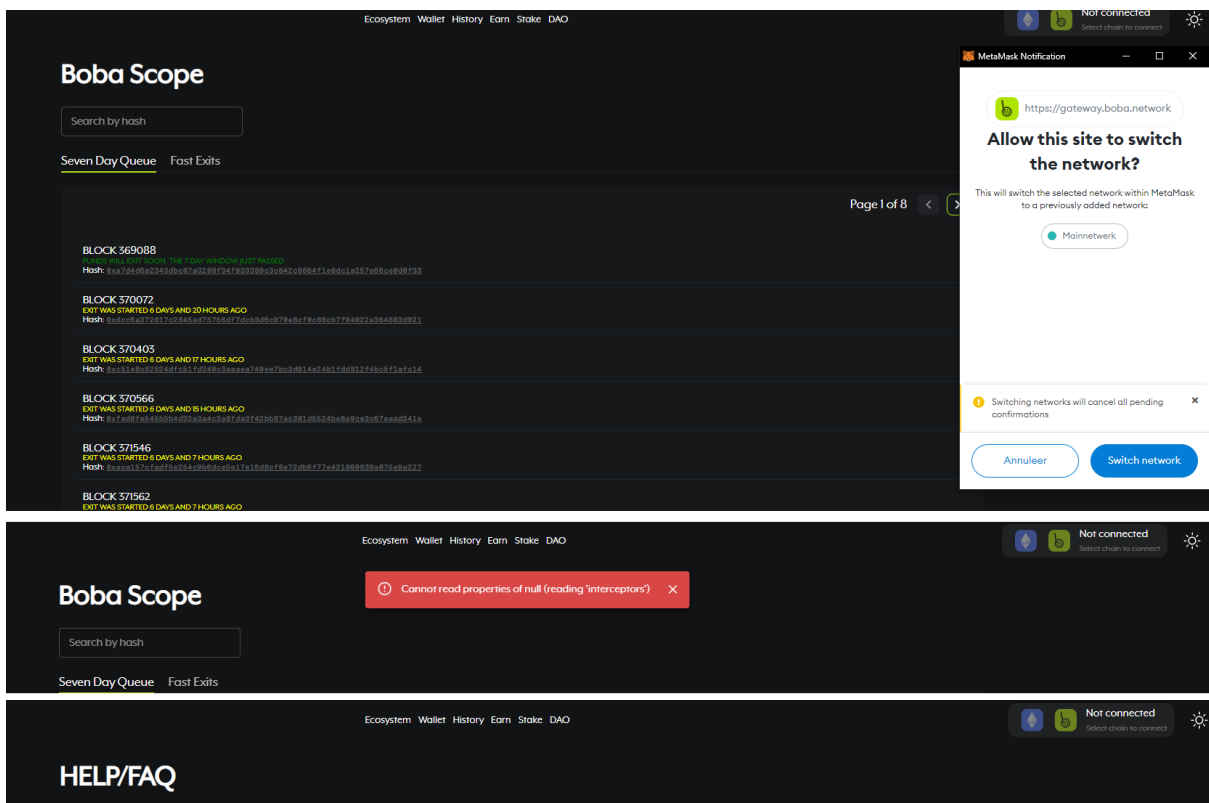
6. Small typo - Boba Websites > **Boba website**



7. Bridge Funds No Feedback Messages - I bridged some tokens from Ethereum L1 to Boba L2, there was no feedback whatsoever the moment my second transaction was confirmed by Ethereum L1 network. The gateway needs to give the user some feedback, that their funds will arrive in minutes... on boba. Same goes for the other way around message from L2 > L1

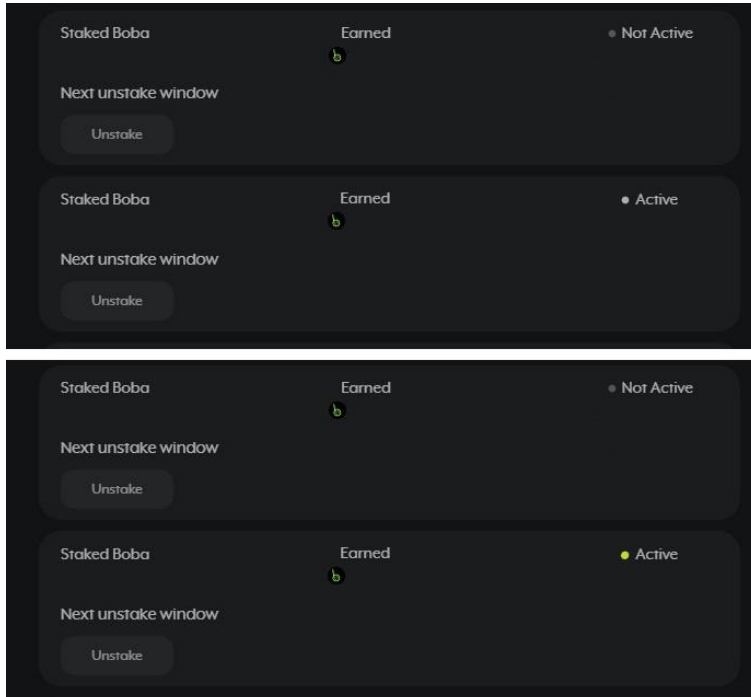


8. Network Switcher Display Broken (Bobascope & FAQ page) - When you try to connect your metamask, and you try to connect it while you are on Bobascope or at the FAQ page, the network switcher display will glitch and shows "Not connected". Even when you are logged in at Metamask. When you switch back to the "wallet page" the network switcher display will work again and shows: connected.

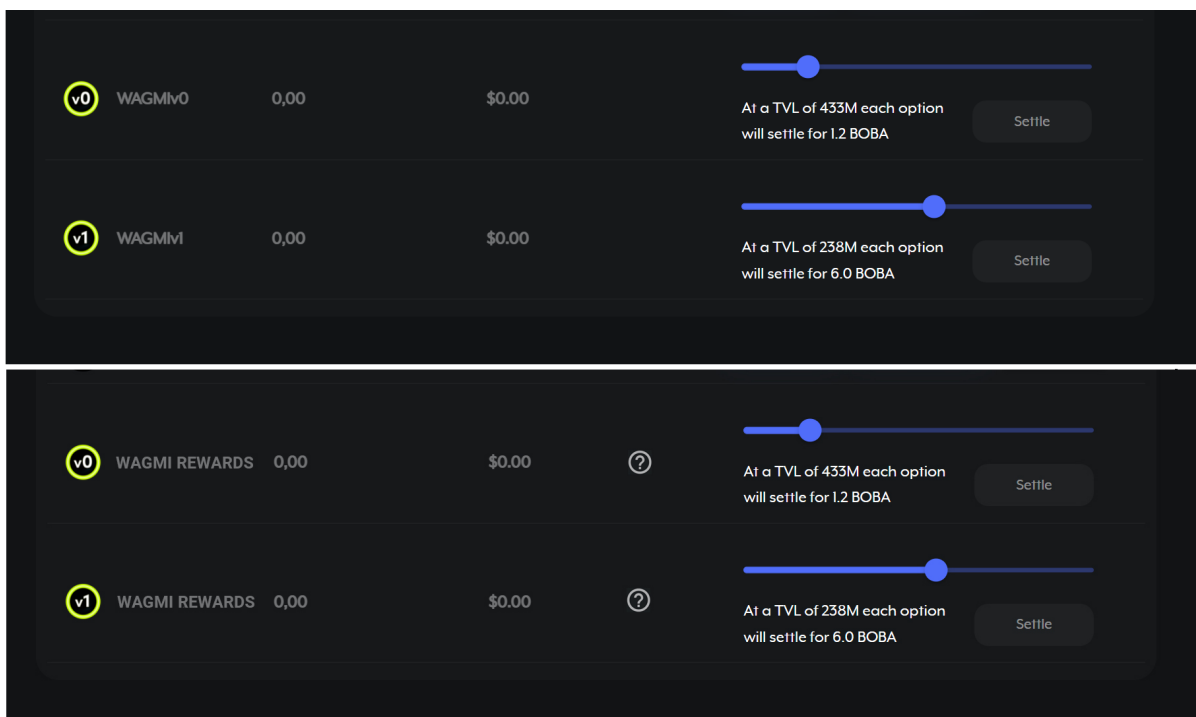

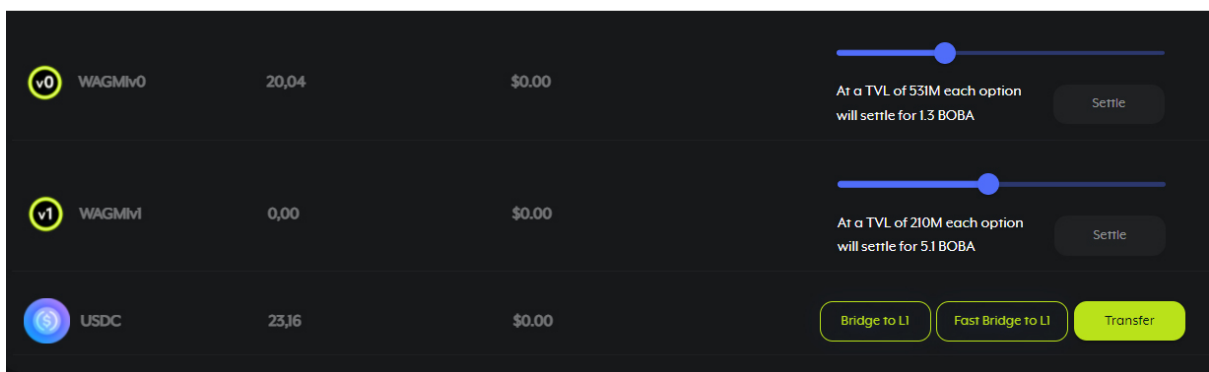
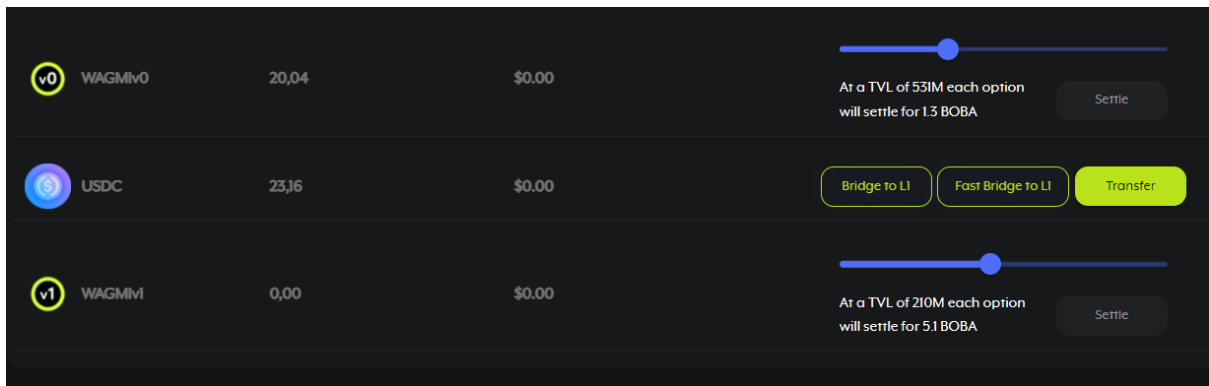
1. Fixed 5% staking - Highlight the "Active" button with a different color circle



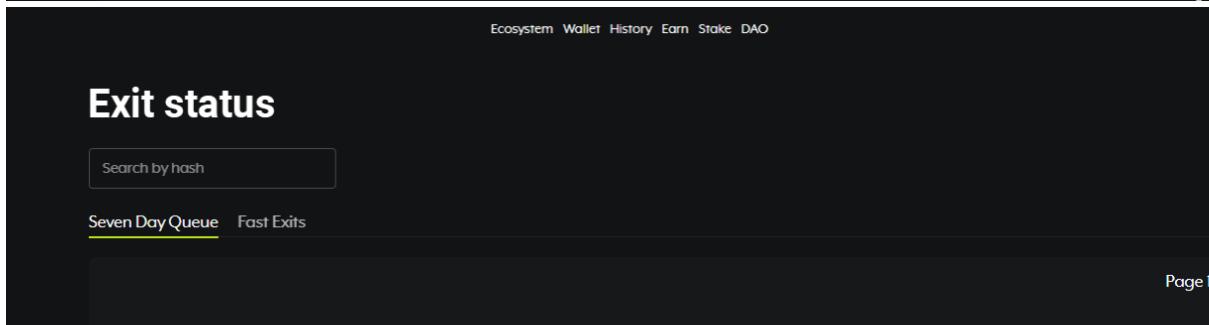
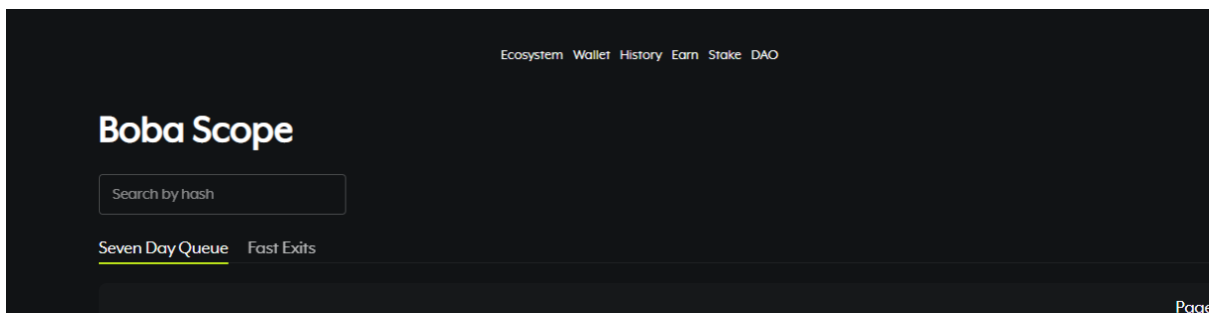
2. Wagmi Options - Add an "Information" icon and explain what Wagmi is. And a suggestion to change the name from WAGMIV0 > **Wagmi rewards** or **Wagmi reward token** in the gateway. So normal users will understand the concept a little bit better. The token icon "v0 and v1" shows the version of the token, so maybe you could ditch the second text "v0 and v1" at the end of the name.



3. Wagmi Options - When you have USDC in your wallet, the Wagmi tokens will be split from each other in the gateway. Maybe try to bundle it, so the wagmi tokens always be next to each other, this with future wagmi versions in mind.



4. Boba scope - Suggestion to make the name more clearer for users and change it from Boba scope > **Exit status**

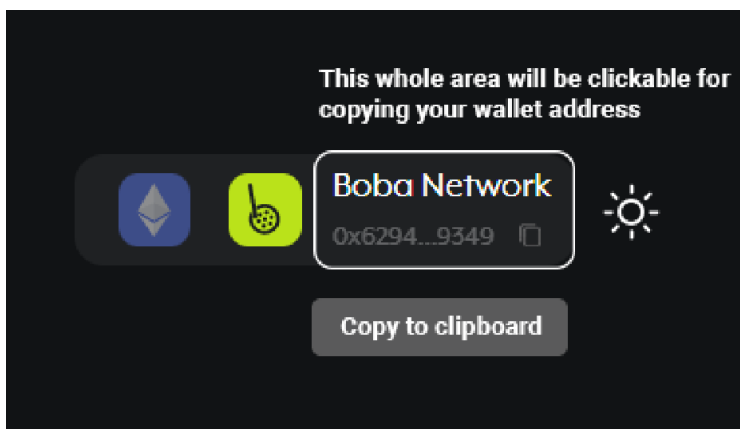
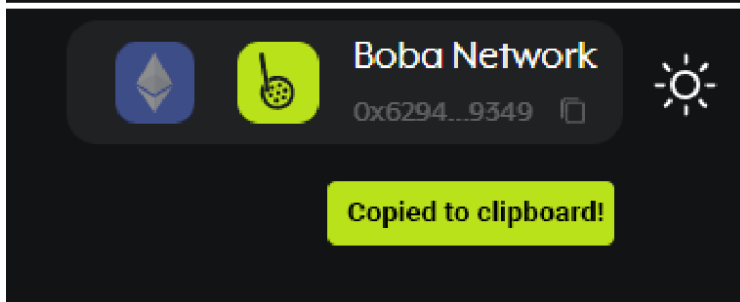
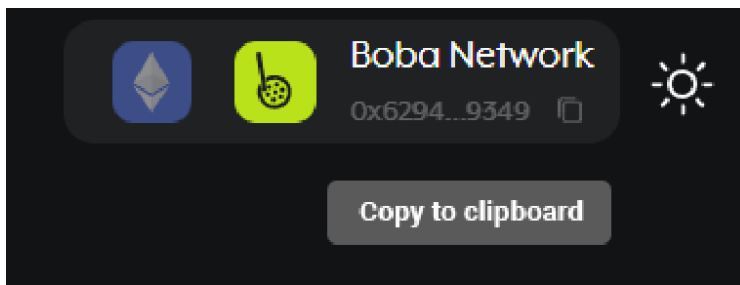


5. Fixed 5% staking - Add an auto-compound option for your staking rewards. At the moment you have to un stake the whole amount to get the rewards and re-stake it again.

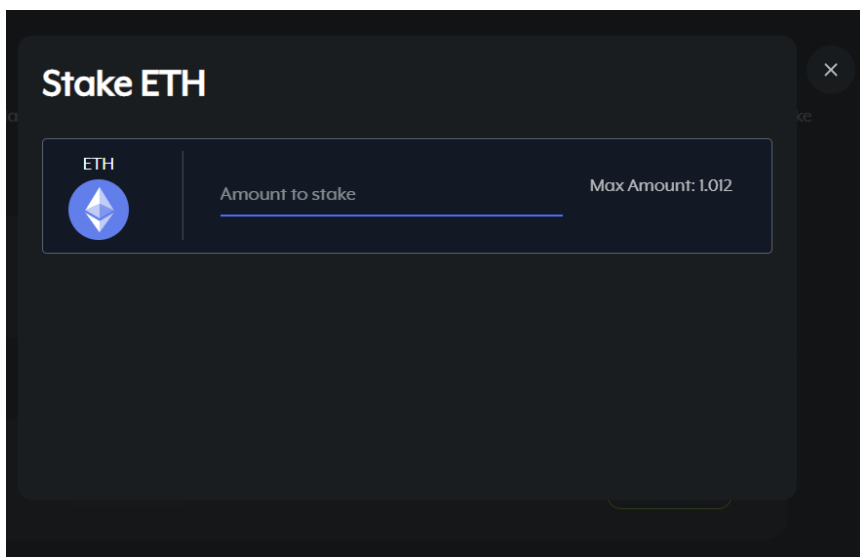
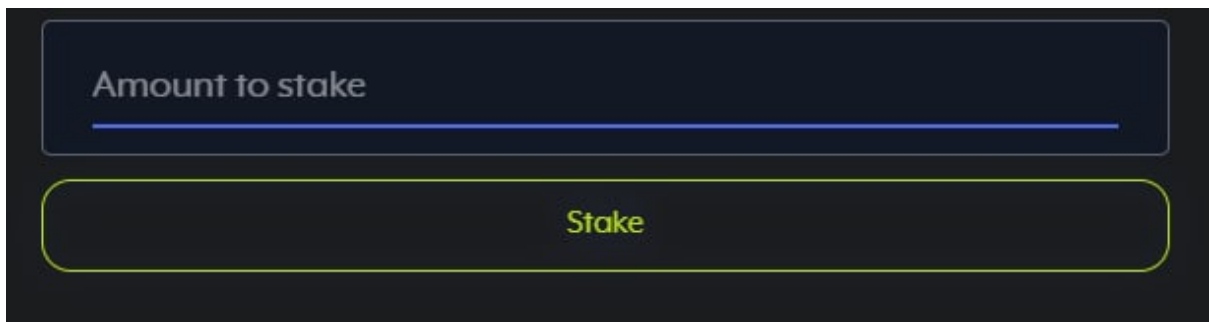
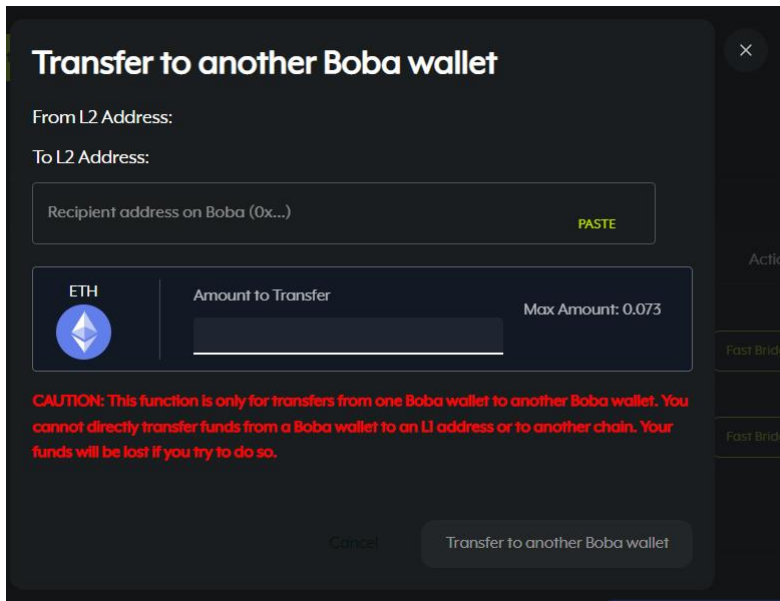
6. Create a “max stake” button (*credit Olongmusk and pepe*) - Suggestion to add a “Max stake” button, so you don’t have to manually fill in the max amount you want to stake at the 5% fixed staking page.

Feature (Lower priority)

1. Wallet copy suggestion (*credit Olongmusk*) - Make the copy wallet button more intuitive for the user, try to put it directly next to the address the user wants to copy. This means the copy button will be smaller, but to compensate for this, you can “copy the address” by clicking on a larger surface area. Also give the user a feedback message when they hover over the address “Copy to clipboard” and when they copied the address “Copied to clipboard”



2.Improve some color schemes and “old design” pop up windows. For example the transfer window and “the fill in” field at the 5% staking page, earn page etc... The window itself is fine, but it’s more the old square design from the old gateway that’s bit out of place.



3.The Ecosystem page - Not really a big priority right now, but it could use a design overhaul to be more in line with the other good looking “pages” on the new gateway.

5. Future - Add some sort of “Tutorial/Learn” button next to the wallet page that redirects the user to some sort of learn center or tutorial on bridging.
