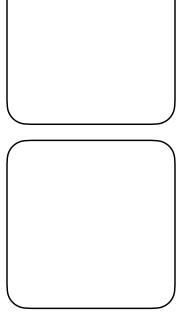

Triggers

Disaster-related death has occurred

Multiple, significant injuries as a result of the disaster

Red Cross member killed, injured or unaccounted for during a Red Cross event or activity

ARC facility damaged as the result of a disaster

Significant evacuation has occurred in a community

Shelter has, or will be, opened or put on standby

Disaster-related incident has significant media coverage

Estimated cost of a disaster-related incident expected to exceed \$10,000

Inter-regional ARC mutual aid requested or expected to occur

State, local, tribal or federal EOC activated and ARC is providing coverage
