A New Year's Eve fire has displaced more than 50 residents from a multi-unit apartment building in Chicago's Avondale neighborhood. Four DAT responders have arrived on scene and are reporting that five units suffered heavy damage; all utilities have been shut off. Residents are currently being housed in CTA warming busses. Mass Care staff have been notified to identify a shelter location. Local ABC, FOX and Unvision affiliates are on scene.
