

### “Cool” Neutral vs “Warm” Neutral, what’s the difference?

Cool Neutrals have a slight blue tone, while Warm Neutrals have a slight brown tone. The temperature of the Neutral should correspond with the dominant colors in the theme. It’s subtle, but in our opinion, it helps the theme colors have more consistency.

### What’s up with the blank colors with nothing attached?

The original idea was to create shades that can be added to a user’s color palette for easy access. That way, if someone doesn’t like the color assigned to a certain shape, they have some different options to choose from that would still match the theme. We haven’t gotten to this yet, so it’s blank for now!
